



### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A357, NEWTON HILL, STURMINSTER NEWTON

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the A357, NEWTON HILL, STURMINSTER NEWTON from 10 metres west of Town Bridge (B3092) to 20 metres east of its junction with Common Lane (The Bull public house), a distance of approximately 150 metres. The notice is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation at 19.00hrs on Tuesday 21 February 2017 and will remain in force for 5 days. The closure will be overnight for 4 nights, between 19.00hrs and 06.00hrs. The road will be open outside of these times. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 06.00hrs on Friday 24 February 2017.

**This notice will enable Dorset County Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.**

A signed diversion route using the "A" road network, will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section. It is indicated by a blue line on the following map.
